Areas of Expertise/Recent Projects

Limestone townhouse (1907) 8,000 SF: Located in the Upper East Side Historic District, this house required complete reconstruction. Essentially a new house built behind an existing facade, the interiors incorporate mantles and antique elements provided by the client and capture the classical spirit of the Beaux Arts Style.

Apartment in the Dakota 3,000SF: The client acquired an adjacent apartment and needed a master plan as well as renovations. The challenge was the creation of a luxurious master bedroom suite and a modern kitchen in a 19th Century building.

Triplex Apartment on Fifth Avenue 4,500 SF: A major reshaping of this historic apartment required extensive structural and mechanical work as a background to new paneled and decorated rooms.
