On January 24, 2007, Eubanks received the "Star of Design" award from the Design Center of the Americas in Dania, Florida, for the category of Interior Design. He also served as the Keynote Speaker for the Opening Ceremonies of Market Week at the Design Center of the Americas for Veranda in 2006, and again for Shelter in 2007. In December 2005, Eubanks was named one of the top fifty designers in the United States by Elements of Living.
